

RATE SCHEDULE LM-10-(B)

LOUP SERVICE TO NON-DISTRICT-OWNED STREET LIGHTING SYSTEMS

LOUP RIVER PUBLIC POWER DISTRICT

AVAILABLE

This rate is available under a contract of standard form to communities, public authorities other than municipalities, and to customers within defined rate areas such as unincorporated communities and areas adjacent to communities in which the District is engaged in the distribution and sale of electricity.

APPLICABLE

To service supplied in the operation of non-District-owned street lighting systems.

CHARACTER OF SERVICE

The customer will construct, own and maintain the complete system. The District will supply energy, furnish and install lamp renewals and patrol the system. Street lighting service supplied under the following rates shall be from dusk until dawn, or approximately 4,000 hours per year.

FRANCHISE DISCOUNT

A discount of 33 1/3 percent shall apply on the above rates to cities and villages in which the District has a valid franchise.

INVESTMENT IN EQUIPMENT

Under this schedule, the District will be required to make no investment in the street light system.

A contribution in the aid of construction may be required from the customer when the overhead line extension to serve the lighting system exceeds 200 feet. The District will furnish the necessary transformation and not more than 200 feet of overhead primary and/or secondary extension.

When the District is required to install an underground extension, the customer shall contribute an amount equal to the difference between the cost of the overhead and underground extensions. This contribution shall be a cash contribution or installation of a portion of the street lighting system as determined by the District. This is in addition to any other contribution required for the extension.
