



6 STEPS TO TAKE WHEN APPROACHED BY A SOLAR DEVELOPER

- CONTACT your local electric utility to find out if they are familiar with the developer and respective solar projects.
- GATHER information about the solar developer such as existing agreements and/or sizes of any proposed or installed project(s).
- SEEK advice from an attorney before signing any easement, contract or document.
- DON'T sign anything unless you are comfortable; don't fall for pressure tactics (e.g. "Your neighbor signed, you should too.")
- DETERMINE the status of any referenced solar projects (e.g. proposed, pending, under construction, online etc.)
